Now The Doll: The Lost Short Stories provides a glimpse of that vision in the making. This slim volume contains eight stories that were originally published in the U.K. volume Early Stories and five that first appeared in periodicals during the 1930s. With the exception of "The Limpet" (1959), all were written before du Maurier had reached the age of twenty-three, and they are, for the most part, experiments in gothic horror, Victorian melodrama, farce, fantasy, and interior monologue.
