1. When to Go Shallow A shallow bowl depth — say, less than 8 inches — is going to be the most comfortable bowl depth for those who are 5 feet, 4 inches or shorter, or who are very tall (6 feet, 2 inches or taller). A shallower bowl depth allows a shorter person to work in the sink without having to lean into it to wash items in the bottom.

Shallow depth of field is achieved by shooting photographs with a low f-number, or f-stop — from 1.4 to about 5.6 — to let in more light. This puts your plane of focus between a few inches and a few feet.

Depending on your subject and area of focus point, you can blur the foreground or background of your image.

What is Shallow Depth of Field? Definitions and Examples

Shallow depth of field is the term used to describe an image that has a shorter field distance. Therefore the region of acceptable sharpness is smaller, and has a higher drop-off rate. A shallow DOF can isolate your subject and cloud surrounding objects. This allows a filmmaker to elicit several different emotions from the viewer.

Shallow depth of field (also called “small” or “narrow”) means that only a part of the image is in focus. The background and sometimes the foreground is blurred. Shallow depth of field works in portrait, nature, and travel photography. The out-of-focus part may be only slightly blurred or be completely lacking detail.

What is Shallow Depth of Field (And How to Use It!)

If you want to get a shallow depth of field then use a larger Aperture, reduce the distance of the subject from the camera, use higher focal length, use smaller Angle of view, increase the distance of the subject from the background. You can try any of these things. I don't recommend to use shallow depth of field for all scenes.

Shallow or Small Depth of Field When the aperture is large (ex. f/1.8), the area in front and behind the focus point is very slim or shallow. That means that objects right in front and right behind the plane of focus is already going out of focus.

### Shallow Depth of Field | Aperture Guide Pt 2

A shallow depth of field describes the small or narrow area that is in focus. Often, the background is blurred while only the subject stays in focus. This shallow or small depth of field can be achieved by increasing the aperture or rather lowering the f/ number.

A shallow depth of field means that only a small portion of the image is sharply focused, while the background (and often foreground) are unfocused. Portraits commonly use a shallow depth of field, because that unfocused quality eliminates anything distracting from the background and draws more attention to the subject.

For the most shallow depth of field, the subject needs to be within a few inches of the iPhone's camera lens. For maximum background blur, the subject needs to be as far away from the background as possible. A telephoto lens attachment can slightly improve the shallow depth of field effect.

Inch and a half is a standard depth for four square, 4"x4"x1-1/2", boxes. This gives you a lot more room for fill. Creating a shallow DOF requires aperture settings that are much wider than standard macro photography, and that means more light will reach the image sensor. Using the strobe power settings from an F22 shot will guarantee a grossly overexposed image when shooting at much shallower depths of field (a result of the wider aperture).

Shallower depth of field is the depth you get when you use a wide aperture. It is confusing, as the word shallow makes you think of the smallest end of the scale. But that's not the case as what you want is the smallest f/stop possible, which means the widest aperture.

This is a depth that is ideal for playing recreational sports or doing very shallow dives. We recommend a depth of 3.5-4 feet for these purposes. This allows people to move quickly enough for games like volleyball while also providing a safe depth for someone to make a shallow (and not head-first) dive. Again, height may be a consideration.
