The saga, begun in Jos é 's novel *Dusk*, traces the life of one family, and that of their rural town of Rosales, from the Philippine revolution against Spain through the arrival of the Americans to, ultimately, the Marcos dictatorship. The first novel here, *Tree*, is told by the loving but uneasy son of a land overseer. It is the story of one young man's search for parental love and for his place in a society with rigid class structures. The tree of the title is a symbol of the hopes and dreams--too often dashed--of the Filipino people. The second novel, *My Brother, My Executioner*, follows the misfortunes of two brothers, one the editor of a radical magazine who is tempted by the luxury of the city, the other an activist who is prepared to confront all of his enemies, real or imagined. The critic I. R. Cruz called it "a masterly symphony" of injustice, women, sex, and suicide. Together in *Don Vicente*, they form the second volume of the five-novel Rosales Saga, an epic the Chicago Tribune has called "a masterpiece."

With these two passionate, vividly realistic novels, *The Pretenders* and *Mass*, F. Sionil Jos é concludes his epochal Rosales Saga. The five volumes span much of the turbulent modern history of the Philippines, a beautiful and embattled nation once occupied by the Spanish, overrun by the Japanese, and dominated by the United States. The portraits painted in *The Samsons*, and in the previously published Modern Library paperback editions of *Dusk* and *Don Vicente* (containing *Tree* and *My Brother, My Executioner*), are vivid renderings of one family from the village of Rosales who contend with the forces of oppression and human nature. Antonio Samson of *The Pretenders* is ambitious, educated, and torn by conflicting ideas of revolution. He marries well, which leads to his eventual downfall. In *Mass*, Pepe Samson, the bastard son of Antonio, is also ambitious, but in different ways. He comes to Manila mainly to satisfy his appetites, and after adventures erotic and economic, finds his life taking a surprising turn. Together, these novels form a portrait of a village and a nation, and conclude one of the masterpieces of Southeast Asian literature.
